

End of a tradition... Beta Sigma Phi cancels Christmas craft sale

Organizers of the much-looked-forward-to Beta Sigma Phi Christmas Craft Sale are sorry to announce that they have decided to cancel the sale this year.

Their sale was always held the first Saturday of November, heralding the start of the Christmas craft season.

Sticky points on the asphalt plant

The issue of rezoning 2 10-acre parcels at the intersection of the truck route & Midday Valley Rd. will soon be back on City Council's table. Peter Bros., the prospective buyer of the 20 acres, already owns the triangular lot across the street and it is zoned M2, upon which it's allowed to build asphalt plants.

Sticky point #1: City Council zoned that triangular lot M2 last January, after the former CEO Matt Noble explained there would be an opportunity to debate the merits of an asphalt plant at the development permit stage. It appears now that isn't the case, as the zoning permits that exact activity.

Sticky point #2: Peter Bros. says it wants to buy the property to store material — enough to last them approx. 3 years — on that site. But they'll only buy contingent on the rezoning to M2. Then a citizen, who is really the listing real estate agent of those properties (asking price \$2million), writes a letter to the editor telling everyone they don't know what they're talking about & poo-pooing the worries about air quality — without stating his conflict of interest...

Sticky point #3: The City of Merritt's own Air Quality Committee discussed the impact of an asphalt plant in the south end of town the week prior to the public hearing. Their minutes state: *the Committee is concerned with the possible health and quality of life effects it may have on residents of the community. The Interior Health Authority and Ministry of Environment representatives both expressed concern and caution in regards to such a development, if that is what the owners of the land intend on constructing. In general, asphalt plants emit high amounts of emissions including fugitive dust from the crushing of material and trucks, primary and secondary PM2.5 particles as well as organics which include noxious odours. Such plants are not regulated and can be difficult to control once they are in operation. Also discussed was the proximity of schools, residential properties and elderly home care facilities to the location, as well as the prevailing south winds from that end of town. It was suggested that maybe a review of the allowable uses of M2 zoning should be done in order to avoid the development of asphalt plants within the City.*


