Cinema fund update

The Merritt Movie Theatre Project is on a tight deadline to their first goal of purchasing the property at the corner of Garcia and Coutlee. They need \$275,000 by Dec 19th (though they have a fall-back option should they not quite meet that amount in time).

Things have revved up quickly since the official announcement of the property acquisition late last month. And now is the time for community members to show their support for the project.

What they need is a groundswell of grassroots support. You can check the progress on the giant thermometer on the site, but be part of it, too!

The society is working to arrange with Interior Savings to be able to accept on-line donations payable to Merritt Community Cinema Society. Regular cheques can be deposited directly at Interior Savings or sent to Merritt Community Cinema Society c/o Margaret Carlson, 1952 Eastwood Ave, Merritt, BC V1K 1K3.

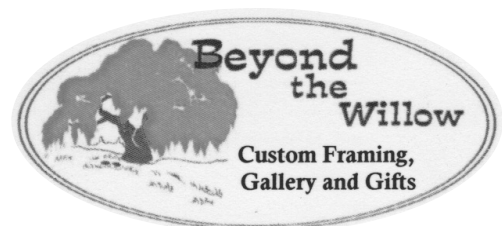

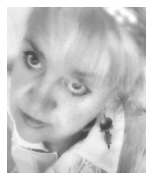
