Merritt re-brands

Until Dec 18, you can give your input to the City's *Destination Brand Online Survey*. They're asking what you want Merritt & the Nicola Valley to be known for.

With City Council's adoption of the proposed 2013-14 Tourism Plan as a guiding document, we embark again on a major re-branding.

Last spring, in conjunction with local tourism stakeholders, and with help from the Thompson Okanagan Tourism Association (TOTA), the plan began to be developed. They identified 3 principal themes: heritage & culture; country (ranching, music, hardworking people); and outdoor recreation.

Mayor Susan Roline says, "Since early this year we have been doing much of the groundwork aimed at developing a more powerful and effective tourism brand, and we are pleased to be working with TOTA in this project, which will be a case study on how smaller communities in the Thompson Okanagan region can improve tourism marketing and attract more visitors."

Sturgis Canada to re-launch in Merritt

After postponing its 2013 festival to make changes to its organizing team, Sturgis Canada (formerly Sturgis North), a music festival and motorcycle rally, confirmed its return: August 21-24, 2014, at the Active Mtn festival site.

"In addition to a new team from across Canada and the US, we've also hired some of Merritt's top local organizers to ensure we meet the city's expectation for a high quality event."

The event is not just for those who ride motorcycles, but will feature two stages. All activities & amenities, including camping, will take place at the festival site. Jasmine Cain is the first performer to be announced. Old Spences bridge

The 82-year-old Spences Bridge over the Thompson River between Hwy 8 and the community of Spences Bridge will be closed permanently as of Jan. 1, 2014.

Engineers have determined that the Old Bridge is not dependable, in poor condition overall with key structural components at the end of their operational life.

The new Spences Bridge on the Trans-Canada Highway, 900m from the old bridge, provides a safe crossing for highway users and the community. The Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure is in consultation with local residents, seeking input on opportunities to improve the trip via the new Spences Bridge for cyclists, pedestrians & motorists.
