In like a lion out like a lamb

BC long range forecast for March

- 1st-3rd. Some rain or (over higher terrain) snow for BC, then clearing and cold.
- 4th-7th. Yet another storm nears Pacific coast by 7th.
- 8th-11th. Dry, fair weather gives way to clouds and a few showers by the 11th.
- 12th-15th. Significant storm brings wind, precipitation, then slides to the S & E.
- 16th-19th. Fair, rather chilly.
- 20th-23rd. Increasingly cloudy skies.
- 24th-27th. Storm from Pacific sweeps rapidly east, bringing unsettled weather.
- 28th-31st. Slow clearing. *farmersalmanac.com*




