Winter Challenge '14

Tidying up a sloppy election process

Branding open house tonight

This evening, 6-8pm, Thompson-Okanagan Tourism Assoc. will present their side of the story for the destination branding, which began a year ago.

The press release for this open house states: "In November 2013 a discovery workshop was held in Merritt to understand how locals see their community and determine what they would want to be known for as a visitor destination.

Preliminary collection of feedback about the essence of the Merritt Nicola Valley experience was received by our branding team. Initial research indicates 3 principle themes: heritage and culture; country (ranching, music, hardworking people); and outdoor recreation. While there was much valuable information gathered from the workshops, additional feedback was collected from tourism stakeholders through an online survey and sessions with council and a focus group of tourism stakeholders."

But the brand question in retrospect is not looking as easy as TOTA might have hoped. When their tag line — *Country with attitude* — hit the public conscience, the backlash was huge and immediate.

And now that we know TOTA didn't make up those sex-sells 'farm fresh' ads (the new economic development officer did), perhaps there's still an opportunity to put forth other suggestions for a tag line that will reflect both the community & the sensibility of the citizens. 


