NVTU rally

The Nicola Valley Teachers' Union held a rally in front of Central Elementary School at 9am yesterday, to bring public attention to the current contract dispute between teachers and the government, and teachers and the Board of Trustees for School District #58.

"One of the key issues in this round of bargaining has been class size and composition" said Peter Vogt, President of the Nicola Valley Teachers' Union. "Class size continues to rise and the number of special needs students in classes continues to rise," he noted.

The government claims there is no money to relieve the pressure of large classes with many special needs students in them. "The government can find money for the 2 billion dollar overrun for the Sea-to-Sky Highway, the 200 million dollar overrun for the cost of a roof at BC Place Stadium and 1.9 billion dollars for the 2010 Olympics, but the government claims they cannot find any money to adequately support students with special needs in classrooms" Vogt noted.

Vogt said the location of the rally is not coincidental. "Central Elementary represents the tip of the ice berg both locally and provincially when it comes to turning a blind eye by both politicians and educational leaders regarding the effects of under funding on the education system" said Vogt.

The school has a class with 28 students with 11 identified special needs students and several classes with more than 4 identified special needs students in them.

Teachers handed out info flyers downtown after the rally.

Review of Personal Info Protection Act

The special committee to review the Personal Information Protection Act has launched a public consultation on the Act (RSBC 2003, c. 63), which governs how private sector organizations can collect, use and disclose personal information. It also requires organizations to protect and secure personal information against unauthorized use or disclosure, and grants individuals the right to access their own personal information.

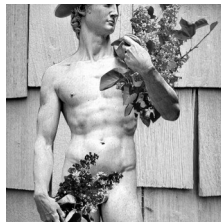

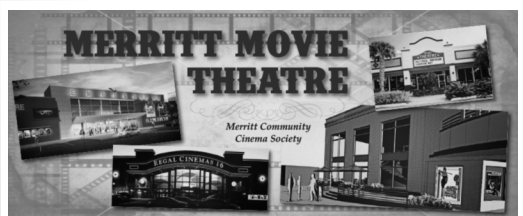

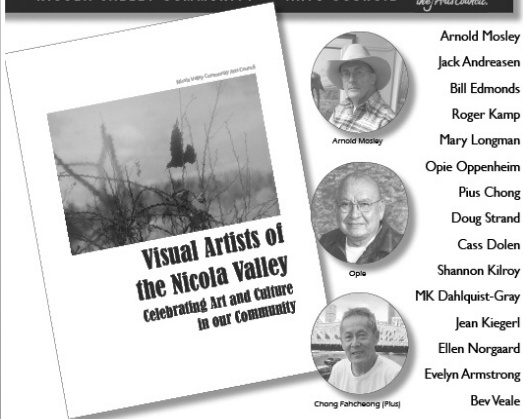
