Higher speed limits

After a provincewide review of safety and speed on rural highways, higher speeds in some areas were announced Wednesday by the Min of Transportation.

Changes coming into effect immediately will be a limit of 110 km/h on Hwy 1 from Whatcom Rd to the junction with Hwy 3, and Hwy 5 from Hope to Othello Rd; and a speed limit of 120 km/h on Hwy 97C from Aspen Grove to the Drought Hill interchange & Hwy 5 from Othello Rd to the Hwy 1 junction near Kamloops. There are no changes to speed limits in Metro Vancouver.

Other changes after review

Winter tires will be required on high mountain passes for 1 less month: Oct 1-Mar 31. However they will be mandatory on all passenger vehicles, chains will only be allowed on commercial vehicles.

In areas with high rates of wildlife collisions, active wildlife detection systems, gateway signs, flashing LED warning lights & wildlife fencing will be installed.

Changes will be made to the Motor Vehicle Act to give police better tools to enforce the requirement for slower vehicles to keep to the right, and new signage and pavement markings will be adopted.

WWI project

The Merritt Library & NV Museum invite you to join them in organizing a multi-year observance of the centenary of the First World War.

The project coordinators, Deborha Merrick & Michael Sasges, are keen to hear from artists, crafts people and writers, as well as younger residents. They are looking to acknowledge and commemorate the social personality of the people of the Nicola Valley in the first two decades of the previous century.

"They were a gregarious people, garrulous, too, I suspect, and the record of their dances and smokers and concerts and lectures and ball games and football matches delights a century later," Mike says.

"Yes, their nights were long, but figuratively and seasonally only. Sure, they had no radio, television or Internet to keep them home, but they kept each other's company well."

Projects are endless and might include: a study group to generate biographies of the Valley's war dead; concerts by Valley musicians and singers, music hall and church hall; exhibitions by painters that re-imagine the famous battlefield paintings of the First World War, or a memorial quilt.


The bloodiest conflict in Canadian history took the lives of at least 40 of the 335 Nicola Valley men who went to war between the summer of 1914 and the fall of 1918.






