New M2 application by Peters Bros. defeated

Last evening, City Council rejected Peters Bros' second application to rezone the same piece of property to allow an asphalt. The first application created an uproar in the community last fall at the public hearing phase.

The consensus this time was that without any new information from the applicant, council would likely face the ire of the community again and be basically in the same situation as before.

'Home-based' bylaw re-vamp defeated

The public hearing for a refreshed home-based business bylaw was held last evening just before the regular council meeting.

The majority of speakers were not in favour of the changes the task force were proposing — double the max. floor space (40m³), double the max. percentage of space (40%), and double the max. number of non-resident employees (2). And a petition with approx. 100 names was submitted against amending the existing bylaw.

A persuasive point made by the public was that the bylaw review was brought about by the non-compliance of one home-based business, whereas they should simply have been found in contravention of the existing bylaw. Councillor Goetz, who chaired the task force, was the only one who voted for the changes. He said that bylaw reviews are needed at times to see if we've fallen behind other communities on certain issues, and that alot of good work was done in the process.

Cricket comes to Merritt

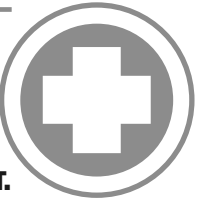

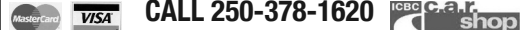
