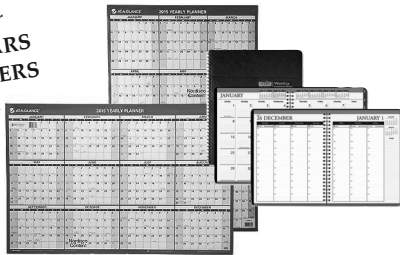

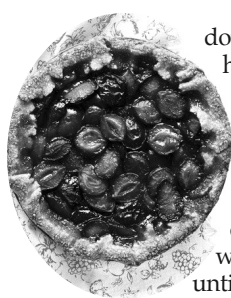

## Plum-and-port crostata

1-1/4 cups all-purpose flour  
1-1/2 teaspoons coarse salt  
1/2 teaspoon granulated sugar  
4 ounces (1 stick) cold unsalted butter, cut into small pieces  
2 tablespoons ice water  
1-1/2 cups ruby port  
1-1/4 cups packed light-brown sugar  
1/2 Thai chile, seeded & minced (opt.)  
2 pounds Italian prune plums, halved and pitted  
1/4 cup cornstarch  
1/4 teaspoon ground cinnamon  
1 teaspoon heavy cream, for brushing  
Sanding sugar, for sprinkling



dough to 1/8-inch thickness. Fit into an 8" pie dish, leaving a 1" overhang. Freeze for up to 30 mins. 3) Preheat oven to 400°. Simmer port and 1/2 cup brown sugar in a saucepan over medium heat until reduced to 1/2 cup, about 25 mins. Transfer to a bowl. Add chile if desired. Cover, and let cool for 10 min. 4) Stir together remaining 3/4 cup brown sugar & teaspoon salt, the plums, cornstarch, cinnamon, and port syrup. Transfer to pie shell. Fold in overhang to form a crust; brush crust with cream, and sprinkle with sanding sugar. Bake for 30 mins; reduce oven to 375°. Bake until golden and center is bubbling, about 1-1/2 hours more. Let cool.


