

## Napier Ranch protected

The Nature Conservancy of Canada and its partners announced on Friday their acquisition of 1,300 acres of native grassland in the Nicola Valley. The \$3.4 million conservation project ensures this habitat will remain intact & undeveloped for migratory birds, rare grassland plants, moose, mule deer, etc.

The acquisition was made possible thanks to Govt of Canada, the Jackson Family, Habitat Conservation Trust Foundation, The Sitka Foundation, the Estate of Thomas T. Forbes and many other individuals.

## 'Highway Angel'

The Truckload Carriers Assoc. has named Bison truck driver Vijaydeep Sahasi a *Highway Angel*, and presented him with a certificate, patch, lapel pin, and truck decal. Manitoba-based Bison Transport also received a certificate acknowledging that one of its drivers is a *Highway Angel*.

In August, Vijaydeep was driving on Hwy 5 just past Merritt when he saw a parked car on the side of the road and a man trying to flag him down. "My wife's having a heart attack!" the man told him.

Vijaydeep called 9-1-1 and was instructed to get the woman out of the car and lie her down on the ground. He had never done CPR before, but with the help of the 9-1-1 operator, Vijaydeep performed the necessary CPR procedure.

During the 30 minutes it took for first responders to arrive, the woman repeatedly started and then stopped breathing. Vijaydeep grew tired, but never gave up, stopping only when paramedics arrived and took over. The woman was taken to the hospital and the next day, her husband called him to share the good news: his wife was doing well, had no cracked ribs or significant problems as a result of the CPR.
