Unofficial election results

City council

With only 34% voter turn-out — a total 1856 votes cast out of an estimated 5426 eligible voters — Neil Menard will be our new mayor, with almost twice the votes as incumbent mayor Susan Roline (994 votes to Susan's 522). Mike Jolly received 297 votes.

Kurt Christopherson was the favourite with 1336 votes, followed by Dave Baker 1241, Mike Goetz 1120, Diana Norgaard 1116, Linda Brown 1099, and Ginny Prowal 824. They will form our new city council. Bruce McMurchy received 765 votes, and Harry Kroeker received 732.

School trustees

The new municipal trustees are incumbents Tim Kroeker 1212 votes & Gordon Swan 988 votes, and returning to the board is Brian Jepsen with 834. Everett Hoisington received 732 votes, and Joyce Perrie 604. For the rural position on the school board, Gerald Ellingsen received 89 votes, to David Laird's 76 and Ko'waintco Michel's 61. Gordon Comeau, David Rainer and Leah Ward were acclaimed for Princeton & Area H.

First Nations Soldiers Conscription — Enslavement?

On November 17, 1917, the Allied Indian Tribes of BC sent a telegram to Prime Minister Borden:

We, chairman and secretary [of the] Committee Allied Tribes of BC consider we should inform you [that] recently announced view [of] Canadian Govt [of] Indians within Military Service Act has caused serious unrest among Indians of this Province, who, while loyal British subjects, yet on account [of] land question not settled and citizenship withheld have long thought rights of men denied them and now having no voice in Canadian affairs, regard enforced military service as enslavement. We are sure any attempted enforcement of Act against Indians would be forcibly resisted and probably cause bloodshed....(excerpted)

The protests of (James) Teit (a pioneer of the Nicola Valley) eventually achieved their aim. In January 1918, a regulation passed by order-in-council exempted Indians from conscription.

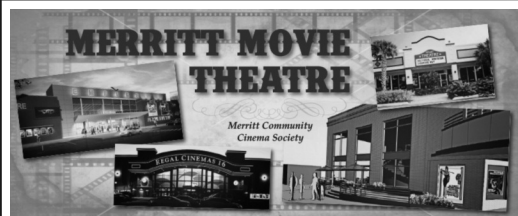
