



**Letter to the editor**  
**Here we go again!**

Here we go again. About thirty years ago, with a 97% vote, we said a resounding "NO" to waste being hauled here from elsewhere.

And now truckloads upon truckloads of reeking biosolid waste ARE being brought here. Biosolids is a word for treated and less-treated sewage with most of the water removed. A few property owners are making money by allowing the sewage to be dumped onto hayfields and grazing areas, having been told it's good fertilizer. (Kudos to the person who thought about it and changed his mind.) The "fertilizer" is made up of not only human excrement, but of course also industrial and pharmaceutical waste; anything that any individual or company lets down the drain. Don't be fooled by the figures we're being given. When you do the math, a smaller-than-allowable percentage of fecal coliform and of lead is still a lot of toxin when it's in such a mind-boggling huge quantity of the smelly guck.

We have been (barely!) managing Merritt's own waste and now many truckloads of such waste are coming from Abbotsford and from the Okanagan. Plans are underway to step this up to a vast facility at Dry Lake, above Miller Estates. If it's so safe and such good fertilizer, why are these cities not keeping it? Why are they paying so much money to have it hauled away? How could the Ministry of Environment approve plans to dump this stuff slightly more than one kilometer from two water sources when Interior Health put a stop to its being dumped a whole 12 kilometers from a water source?




If we allow this scheme to accelerate, our valley will not be a pleasant or healthy place to live. The wind will blow the unbearable stench to and through our city. Think what you might be consuming in the water or in any locally grown food, what you might be inhaling in the air. Potentially, so much for tourism. Would you come here?

Citizens of our beautiful valley: The Ministry of Environment, and also those who stand to profit, are assuming that we few hicks will be too apathetic and ignorant to notice the magnitude of what is happening, or to object. Will we be?






