Variable speed zones

On Friday, Transportation Minister
Todd Stone outlined the province's new
10-year transportation plan.

One of the highlights: variable speed
limits, with signs and sensors in the road,
tied to the ministry's traffic-management
centre in Coquitlam, to provide a variable
max. speed for motorists during snow or
heavy rains, for example. 3 zones will be
operational with variable speed limits be-
fore next winter: west of Revelstoke, near
the snowshed on the Coq, and on the Sea
to Sky Hwy between Vancouver &
Whistler. They'll be able to dial back the
speed limit from 120 km/hr to what's ap-
propriate for the weather conditions.

The project will cost about \$24 million
for the 3 locations, each section is 10-12
km in length. Similar technology is used
in Europe, where it's reported to reduce
collisions and save lives.

Biosolids issue

The Friends of the Nicola Valley, now al-
most a 1,000 strong (and supported by a
local petition of some 3,000), have been
struggling hard for many months now to
safeguard our local environment. Our vis-
ible protests along Hwy 8 have rallied a great
deal of community support and awareness
on this issue. So many have expressed their
joy at working together (First Nations and
non-Native peoples of the Valley) to bring
about change — to work towards a future
that will ensure health and security for
everyone living in this wonderful valley.

What is our goal? Simply this: to end
all importation of sewer sludge into our
valley, and to immediately have the facil-
ity on Sunshine Valley Road dismantled,
and the sludge piles taken back to the
communities that trucked it here. This is
a modest request. This is a reasonable re-
quest. Mostly however, it is a fair request!

Other communities must look after their
own sewer sludge. We will not be the dump-
ing ground for the concentrated end-product
of other people's water treatment facilities.
We will not stand idly by and watch the
heavy metals and other toxins accumulate in our forest, on our lands, or in our waters.

Our tourism economy will only suffer as we get buried deeper and deeper by other
cities' toxic waste. But also, First Nations Elders have spoken about their grave con-
cern about the disruption of traditional hunting and gathering in the forests. They
have spoken about not being able to drink from the streams they once did, or eat the
herbs and berries they once collected. This land application of sewer sludge is a dis-
graceful and disrespectful attack on this population and their way of life.

Together, as Friends of the Nicola Valley, we are going to continue this battle to
end this insidious practice. We know we are doing what is best for our valley, for our
people, and for the future. Many of us have never protested before, never carried a
sign before, never written to our MLA's before, but this issue has galvanized us to
stand firm and fight for what is right. Rest assured, we will not stop this protest until
our goals are addressed and our valley is safe.
