Active Transportation Merritt

Bikes Belong in Merritt is a grassroots effort to encourage bicycles and active transportation in the infrastructure planning and culture of Merritt.

Last evening, Lindsay Fehr made a presentation to City Council on behalf of the group. They’ve mapped out a continuous bike route that circles the downtown area — east from Voght along Coldwater to Orme, along Coutlee, onto Blair, then Granite to Cleasby. From there, north past Rotary Park & up the hill on Voght to connect the North End with downtown. Or south to Quilchena, onto Main & linking up along the Coldwater River Path, back to Claybanks Park.

Research shows that making paths and bike lanes encourages their use. And communities planning today are including & encouraging active transportation.

The group’s grand vision? For pedestrians: good quality sidewalks, well-marked & well-lit crosswalks, and lower speeds downtown. For bikes: clearly marked & continuous trail, allowing children to bike safely to school & residents to get safely downtown. For the community: better choices for active transportation, better health, and a better chance of becoming a family-oriented sustainable community.

And the group believes that as the City replaces, repairs & repaints our streets, a bike route project could easily and affordably be incorporated into each project, with much of the work simply falling within the scope of public works. They’re willing to wait for the project to be completed over several years — as long as we’re working towards a plan.

Report from the first annual Merritt Business Walk

Survey results from the joint CF-City-Chamber Business Walk initiative have been compiled. Volunteers canvassed businesses to learn about their perceptions on local economic conditions & issues. This is what they found:

86 Responses were received. 56% have been operating for more than 10 years. 30% felt their business is ‘good/increasing sales’. 65% chose Merritt because of ‘location’. 28% chose Merritt because of ‘affordability’. 52% viewed ‘consumer leakage’ as a medium or high threat.

Top 3 challenges/threats: consumer leakage; lack of local government support; and, inadequate signage. Top 3 suggestions to help business thrive: improved local govt support ie. effective economic development, improved signage, reduced red tape, lower taxes (62%); improved marketing/promotions and increased partnerships (25.5%); signage ie. downtown, highway and on the Bench to create awareness of the downtown businesses and attractions (17.5%). Additional mentions fell under beautification/increased bylaw enforcement ie. litter, unsightly premises & snow removal.

“The feedback confirms that the City is on track in its efforts to promote economic development, help businesses grow, keep taxes affordable and encourage local shopping. Plans to enhance community signage, beautify Nicola Avenue in partnership with the Ministry of Transportation and a continued focus on bylaw enforcement targeting unsightly properties align well with business owners wants and needs” said Mayor Neil Menard.

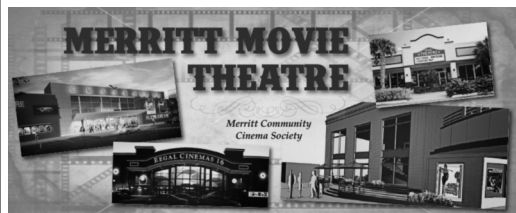
