## Smoky skies again

Major smoke was blown in from far-off fires again this weekend. The bulk of it has been coming from the Harrison Lake fire and a new one near Lytton, but on Monday evening, a grass fire near the Coldwater exchange on the Coquihalla added to the zero visibility.

A vehicle fire closed the highway late Monday afternoon. The fire spread into the dry, grassy median, stopping traffic and creating lineups on the busiest long weekend. 7 BC Wildfire Service personnel responded and the fire was contained to the centre median. The scene was cleared by about 6pm.

Another vehicle fire yesterday, near the snowshed, closed the Coq for 3 hours. The fire was contained to the truck.

## Contaminants identified in sludge

John Werring, Senior Science Advisor with the Suzuki Foundation, recently visited our area and listened to concerns raised by the Chiefs & members of Friends of the Nicola Valley. He also took samples from some of the biosolids which had been dumped in the valley. The results from the independent lab's tests showed numbers indicating that the "soils" could be categorized as a "contaminated site" according to the BC Contaminated Sites Regulations guidelines — if they were not biosolids.

The samples exceed the BC limits for contaminated sites under Schedules 4 and 7 of the BC Contaminated Sites Regulations for all of the following parameters: cadmium, copper (very high), mercury, molybdenum (1 of 2 samples), selenium, sodium ion, tin, zinc (very high) 2,4- and 2,5-dichlorophenol, 3 & 4 methylphenol, Total PAH (0.815 ug/g average of 2 samples ... BCCSR limit is 0.1 ug/g), Phthalates (di (2-ethylhexyl) phthalate - AKA - DEHP)

These findings support the local position that the practice of land application of biosolids is far too risky to be continued.

Chief Aaron Sam said, "The independent tests confirm that biosolids must not be applied to land. Biosolids contaminate our lands and waters, and it has serious potential negative effects on fish, animals and plants, First Nations people are reliant on the land for food and medicines. Biosolids put the health of our community members at risk! We can no longer sit back while the Government of British Columbia ignores our Constitutionally protected rights to our title and rights!"
