Sagebrush under new management

Sagebrush Golf Club will re-open the golf course in the spring under Troon, a company based out of Arizona & leader in upscale golf course management. It will be Troon's first managed property in Canada, expanding the company's global portfolio to include 30 countries.

Newmark Group purchased Sagebrush on Nov. 1 last year and recently named James Cronk, a highly regarded Canadian golf industry executive, as President of Newmark Golf Group. They have also hired the Vancouver design firm SSDG Interiors to renovate the Badlands Clubhouse, which is now underway. Many other enhancements are planned and will be phased in as the property 'builds upon its unique offering.'

Re: property assessments

Property values remain stable for 2016

According to BC Assessment, most of the more than 3,500 properties in Merritt are remaining stable in value compared to last year's Assessment Roll: in the -10% to +5% range. Overall, the Merritt assessment roll increased from \$892 million last year to over \$893 million this year. Of note, a total of just over \$5 million was added through subdivisions, rezoning and new construction.

The "typical" value of a home in Merritt in 2016 is \$241,000, up from \$236,000 in 2015. If a property owner is concerned about their assessment after speaking to a BC Assessment appraiser, they may submit a Notice of Complaint (Appeal) by February 2, for an independent review by a Property Assessment Review Panel. Of special interest this year, is BC Assessment's newly-enhanced & free to use *e-valueBC* service that allows the general public to search, check and compare properties online from across the province. You can easily find property information on any property in BC, view and update your property details, compare neighbouring properties, and compare sales & assessment values.

There are street views of each house (some from Google, some from BC Assessment), detailed property info (ie. number of bedrooms, baths and total square footage), land & building value (current & previous), year built, property type, land size, legal description, sales history within the last 3 years & comments on the property. There is also a "sample sold property" tab that brings up similar & nearby properties to the one you just searched... along with the value & sale price.

The most impressive is the interactive map where each lot is linked to the above info and you can click through your neighbours' lots and see their info in the handy pop-up window. And it is available to the public year-round. If you're at all interested in real estate in this town, check it out... it's entertaining & informative.


