Funding approved for water treatment

The City of Merritt has received approval of Federal Gas Tax funding for the water treatment upgrades through the Strategic Priorities Fund (SPF). The funding will cover 100% of the actual eligible costs — \$2.28 million to install UV light reactors on existing wells that supply the city with drinking water.

This upgrade will provide another level of security for our water system. The City has been working towards acquiring this funding for several years, and was granted it after a letter of support from Interior Health Authority.

The next step for the project will be to undertake detailed design, with project tendering anticipated in the fall.

This project is one of 57 projects being funded through the Strategic Priorities Fund under the Federal Gas Tax Fund for 2016. Each year, the Government of Canada provides over \$253 million in indexed funding for local government infrastructure projects across BC through the federal Gas Tax Fund.

FONV support biosolids protestors in Clinton

On Saturday, members of Friends of the Nicola Valley joined protestors gathered in Clinton in a bid to stop the dumping of sewage sludge in the Big Bar Lake area. Biosolids protestors there ramped up their efforts following a spill in Big Bar Creek on February 4th. A sludge truck hit black ice & spilled part of its load into the creek, about 10 km from its OK Ranch destination.

A total of 5 cubic metres spilled, and the Ministry of Environment said there is “little risk to the public”, though , they also stated that “a very small percentage of pathogens may still be present in treated biosolids,” and warned the public to keep themselves and pets away from the area until the environment ministry and Interior Health Authority can rule out potential health risks.

Now, Canoe Creek/Dog Creek Chief Patrick Harry is calling for a moratorium on the transport of biosolids in their territory. The Chiefs of the 5 Bands of the Nicola Valley issued their moratorium in October 2015.

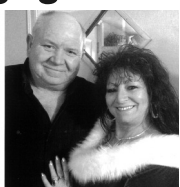
