Variable speed signs

Last week, 13 variable speed signs on the Coq, between Portia Interchange and the former Toll Plaza, went into effect.

The speed signs will change to reflect driving conditions. Flashing lights above each sign will be active when a reduced speed limit is in effect.

The ministry invested \$12.5 million to install and run the pilot systems, which is part of the ministry's \$25-million per-year Road Safety Improvement Program.

There are also 16 variable speed signs on Hwy 99 between Squamish & Function Junction at Whistler, and 18 signs on Hwy 1 west of Revelstoke between Perry River Bridge & Hwy 23 South interchange.

The loss of senator Len Marchand

Regional Chief Shane Gottfriedson and the BC Assembly of First Nations would like to express our profound sorrow and heartfelt condolences on the loss (Fri., June 3rd) of Senator Len Marchand, at age 82.

We wish to pay tribute to this great man who has achieved, in his lifetime, enormous accomplishments, including being one of the first Aboriginal students to enroll at UBC, the first First Nations man elected to Parliament (for Kamloops-Cariboo), the first appointed to serve as Cabinet Minister. Appointed to the Canadian Senate in 1984, Len Marchand's contributions to advancing Aboriginal issues at the local, provincial, and federal levels cannot be understated: today we lost an outstanding advocate and an inspiration to Aboriginal peoples across Canada.

Sen. Marchand's achievements are testimony to how one man, through sheer courage and tenacity, can rise up to the challenge and make a difference in the lives of Aboriginal peoples and countless others across the country.

His charisma, kindness, and compassion left an indelible impression on all who were fortunate to meet him. Sen. Marchand's legacy reminds us of the work we must continue to do, the issues we must continue to advance, and our values that we can never take for granted. First Nations communities will forever draw inspiration from Sen.

Marchand's lifelong and selfless dedication and efforts to promote a culture of peace, justice and reconciliation.
