Angling closed on 3 local rivers

The Province has temporarily shut down fishing on Nicola River, Coldwater River and Spius Creek, to help protect steelhead and other trout from health risks associated with rising water temperatures. Fishing is closed until further notice.

When stream temperatures rise above 20°C, the mortality rate of catch-and-release trout increases. Under the federal Fisheries Act, the Province is responsible for non-salmon freshwater fisheries, including sea-run steelhead, cutthroat and Dolly Varden.
