BC Farmers Appreciation Week Sept. 12-18, 2016

In 2015, sales of BC agrifood products topped more than \$13 billion, the highest ever. Meantime, the net cash income for primary agricultural production increased 21.5% in 2015 to \$440 million, up from \$362 million in 2014.

The B.C. Agrifood and Seafood Strategic Growth Plan identifies the next steps in our goal to grow the overall sector to a \$15-billion-a-year industry by 2020. New tools for trades at NVIT

Students at NVIT will benefit from \$100,000 in funding from the provincial government, toward the purchase of new industry-standard trades equipment, including portable welding booths that will enable students to prepare for jobs in the trades.

In addition to trades-equipment funding, NVIT has received more than \$207,000 since the launch of BC's *Skills for Jobs Blueprint* for 52 critical trades seats (delivered in partnership with Okanagan College) as well as \$1.5 million toward a new \$1.8-million trades training facility that officially opened in October 2015.

Nearly one million job openings are expected in BC over the next decade, and 8 out of 10 of these openings will require post-secondary education. In-demand occupations requiring post-secondary education or training range from professional to management to trades.

Royal visit comes to the Okanagan

From Sept. 24 to Oct. 1, their Royal Highnesses, the Duke of Cambridge and the Duchess will be visiting BC. The itinerary includes various events that are open to the public:

Saturday, Sept. 24: Official Welcome to Canada - Parliament Buildings, Victoria.

Sunday, Sept. 25: Arrival in Vancouver, Jack Poole Plaza.

Tuesday, Sept. 27: Arrival at UBC Okanagan, Kelowna.

Saturday, Oct. 1: Official departure from Canada, Inner Harbour, Victoria.

Also as part of their tour, Their Royal Highnesses will officially endorse the Great Bear Rainforest under *The Queen's Commonwealth Canopy* initiative. The Great Bear Rainforest covers 6.4 million hectares on BC's north and central coast, and is home to 26 separate First Nations. *The Queen's Commonwealth Canopy* hopes to raise awareness of the value of saving forests and facilitate knowledge exchange between Commonwealth members, sharing best practices and creating new, collaborative initiatives for forest conservation.

Plum Smoothie-Pop

¼ c. sugar
1 tbsp. corn syrup
1 lb. assorted plums
8 tsp. fresh lime juice
6 oz. plain yogurt

Bring the sugar, corn syrup, and 1/4 cup water to a boil in a small saucepan. Remove from heat and cool. Puree the plums, cooled syrup, and lime juice in two batches, using a blender, until smooth. Stir the plum puree and yogurt together in a large mixing bowl.

Pour the mixture into popsicle molds, leaving about 1/2 inch at the top, as the mixture will expand when it freezes. Follow popsicle mold manufacturer's instructions and freeze until solid — about 4 hours.

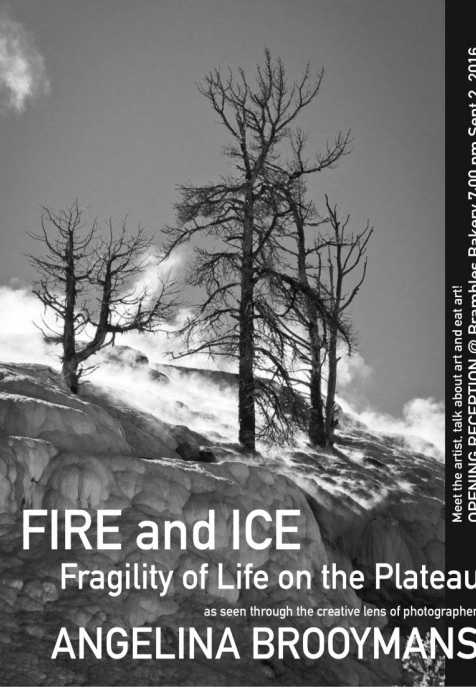
