Grilled kale salad w/ ricotta & plums

4 tbsps extra-virgin olive oil, divided
3 tbsps balsamic vinegar
1 teaspoon honey
3/4 cup fresh ricotta
2 teaspoons chopped fresh thyme
Kosher salt, freshly ground pepper
4 med. plums, halved, pitted, thinly sliced
12 large or 16 small curly kale leaves

Whisk 3 tbsp. oil, vinegar, thyme & honey in a medium bowl. Season vinaigrette to taste with salt & pepper. Add plums & toss to coat; transfer plums to a plate.

Heat a gas grill to high. Brush kale leaves with 1 Tbsp. oil; season with salt. Grill kale, turning once, until crispy and charred at edges, about 2 mins. Let cool enough to handle, remove large center stems with a knife and discard. Divide ricotta among plates; season with salt and pepper. Stir vinaigrette again. Tear larger kale leaves into pieces (leave smaller leaves whole). Place leaves in a large bowl and toss with some of the vinaigrette. Divide leaves among plates. Top with plums and drizzle some vinaigrette over.

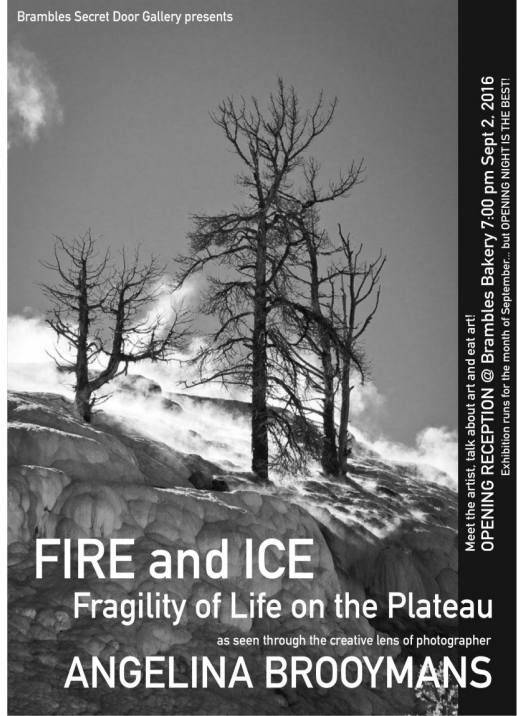
