Network of EV charging stations growing

Merritt has had its electric vehicle charging stations for a couple years, now. But BC Hydro has just completed Phase 1 of their network of fast charging stations — 30 of them — that connects drivers from the Lower Mainland to Merritt and Kamloops, up to Whistler, Vancouver Island and the Southern Interior.

Fast charging stations can charge an electric vehicle's battery to 80% in 30 mins. BC Hydro has been installing the stations since 2012 with support from prov'l and fed'l govt's and in partnership with municipalities throughout the province.

300,000 electric vehicles are expected to be on BC roads by 2030. BC has become a leader in electric vehicles policies, infrastructure and revising building codes.

Casting call for filming in Merritt

Canadian Production *Indian Road Trip* is casting for 4 speaking roles. Auditions will take place Saturday October 1, in NVIT's Green Room, 1 - 5pm.

Allan W. Hopkins wrote and will direct the film. He is originally from the N'quatqua First Nation in Lil'wat traditional territory. They are casting for a white (Caucasian) middle class family: female/ daughter - blond hair, fair complexion, 9 years old; male/ son - blond hair, fair complexion, 7 years old; female/ mother - blond hair, fair complexion, around 30 years old, fit; male/ father - brown or blond hair, fair complexion, around 30 years old, fit. Actors will be paid.

On audition day, wear casual clothes as if going on a Sunday drive. Auditioners will be given part of the script to practice lines and then your audition will be taped at the casting session. Each role will have 3 to 4 lines and will be in the film's opening scene. Filming will be October 11, in Merritt, all day. Must be legal to work in Canada & have own transportation.

The story is a comedy and is about two bored & disenchanted Indian teenagers, forced to drive a cranky elder across the reserve so she can visit her dying sister. It quickly becomes clear that a supernatural force is trying to halt the journey, and on the slowest road trip in movie history, (the elder will only ride in a car that is going no faster than 10kms/hr), the boys learn that the Rez is a more magical & mysterious place than they ever imagined.




