



Biosolids protests are back!

Yesterday, Friends of the Nicola Valley held a rally on Voght St. near City Hall, despite the traffic turmoil downtown. And another one is set for today, 4pm on Gasoline Alley — a prime location for long weekend travellers. They will have signs, and supporters are invited to join them.

These are in the wake of 2 significant biosolids events last week. Minister of Environment Mary Polak invited a public review and individual feedback on a policy intentions paper for the continued use of the organic matter recycling regulation (OMRR), with a few new requirements for the management and use of biosolids.

As well as the publication of the findings by the govt's Technical Working Group's review of Biosolids (as a soil amendment in agriculture, landscaping and site reclamation) formed in June 2015 as a result of the protests by Friends of the Nicola Valley & the moratorium by the Chiefs of the 5 First Nations in the valley.

Members of the Friends of the Nicola Valley continue to be skeptical & critical of the govt's methods. Over the past 18 months, they have educated themselves about issues surrounding 'toxic sewer sludge' from across the continent, and beyond. And they believe that the 'sludge industry' is the government's consultant.

Randy Murray posted on facebook/ Friends of the Nicola Valley: "Polak and her spin doctors have brought the issue back to the science only. Their scientific review criteria is flawed, no inclusion of nano plastics, pharmaceuticals or the thousands of chemicals in biosolids or other toxins they don't understand. They make no mention of consultation vs notification... no permit required... The professional reliance model is still in play (agrologists and industry decide and advise government)... Property values will continue to suffer ... tourism will continue to be negatively impacted... ranchers and farmers have no incentive to move to a sustainable model, just keep pumping the biosolids into the land..... no mention of the danger to wildlife, and a disregard for First Nations concerns..."

"To have Minister Polak publicly state [in a recent Q101 interview] that folks with a differing perspective on biosolid land application are out of step with world wide environmentalists is not only disrespectful, it is a veiled attempt to discredit in order to gain political advantage on the cusp of an election... very transparent!" posted Randy.

And with election coming, some members of FoNV will be "making this an issue for Ms Tegart and the Liberal party, who continue to pander to the sludge industry instead of exploring safe alternatives such as Waste to Energy processing of human sewage," said FoNV's Georgia Clement in a facebook posting.
