

Douglas Lake Rd. repaving complete

The realignment and paving of Douglas Lake Rd, approx. 40 km east of town, is now complete.

This was an important infrastructure project for the Upper Nicola Indian Band and other users like the Douglas Lake Cattle Company, as the straightening out and paving this 4-kilometre section has made travelling Douglas Lake Road much safer. The re-alignment provides better sightlines for drivers and safer conditions, including paved shoulders.

Open burning bans (cat. 2 & 3) rescinded

Effective at noon on Saturday Oct 15, Category 2 & 3 open burning prohibitions were rescinded throughout the Kamloops Fire Centre.

The rescinding applies to all BC Parks, Crown lands and private lands, but does not apply within the boundaries of a local government that has forest fire prevention bylaws and is serviced by a fire department.




