

Travis Fehr of Breathe Bikes will be taking this winter off, unlike other years. So this week is the last chance for any end-of-season bike enhancements or repairs. After October 31st, everything has to wait until spring.

Flu season

Interior Health holds public clinics for those who are eligible for the free flu shot — those at risk of complications from influenza & those in contact with people at risk. Check out the eligibility factors at www.interiorhealth.ca

In Merritt, public clinics will be held Nov 2, 9am-4pm, at the Civic Centre, free if eligible, drop in. Nov 30, 9:30am-4pm, by appointment at the Merritt Public Health office at the Hospital, call 378-3400 for appt. And at the Extra Foods pharmacy Mon-Fri 9am-9pm, Sat 9am-6pm, Sun 10am-6pm, free if eligible & privately, just drop in. Most doctor's offices & pharmacies are also providing flu shots. Those who are not eligible for the free vaccine will be required to pay a fee.

This year's flu shot offers protection against two influenza A viruses (an H1N1 & an H3N2 virus) and one influenza B virus. For those under 18, the preferred vaccine also protects against an additional B influenza virus.

Interior Health also reminds the public that visitors are required to have had a flu shot or wear a mask when visiting patients in Interior Health or its contracted facilities during the influenza season. This helps protect the people you are visiting from getting a potentially serious illness. IHA reports that every year in Canada, about 12,200 people are hospitalized and 3,500 people die from influenza or its complications.


