

Super 'Frost Moon'

The full moon in November is known as the *Frost Moon*. Today, the moon will pass closer to the Earth than it has in almost 70 years: since 1948 to be exact. And it won't be as close — a mere 356,508 km to the Earth — again until 2034. It will have been at its closest just before dawn this morning, but will be almost equally visible last night and tonight.


