City to champion community theatre

Last night, City council voted to apply under the *Special Circumstances* category of the Rural Dividend Fund in the amount of \$3.2 million dollars for the construction of the community theatre, and partner with the NV Community Theatre Society on the application.

With the closing of Tolko Nicola Valley and the loss of more than 200 jobs, the 'special circumstances' resonates all the more for the community. And at last month's UBCM, City Councillors heard from various Ministry staff that any application they made would be considered 'top of the pile'.

It will be a joint application with the City being the lead applicant, and the theatre society preparing the application. The City's support is non-financial.

Reward offered in case of animal cruelty

Angel's Animal Rescue is offering a reward for information about the hanging death of a dog on the Coldwater Reserve. The notice was posted on their facebook page on Nov. 18: "We are offering a substantial reward for information leading to the apprehension of the man/men or woman/women that committed the cruel act of wrapping a dog's muzzle with barbed wire and hanging it. This animal was found dead at the Coldwater Reserve. Please contact Angel's Animal Rescue or Merritt RCMP to report any information you may have in regards to this incident. If you have information pertaining to other animal cruelty acts please call Angel's Animal Rescue, the RCMP or the SPCA. Be brave, don't turn a blind eye to what you know is wrong. To protect you, your information can remain completely private."

Police have confirmed that the incident took place on Nov. 1. "We've identified the dog's owner and we also have some suspects that we're investigating at this time," said Const. Tracy Dunsmore.

'BCHighways' app

A new free app will provide easy-to-access road info and maps. *BCHighways* provides real-time access to provincial highway information — road closures, planned roadwork, and extreme weather conditions, estimated border crossing wait times, and traffic camera images.

The app was developed by AirSenze Solutions, a Victoria-based mobile app devel't firm, and uses data from DriveBC. No taxpayer dollars involved!
