Kinder Morgan plans to break ground late 2017

Kinder Morgan Canada plans to break ground on its newly approved \$6.8-billion Trans Mountain pipeline expansion project in September of next year, though president and CEO Ian Anderson understands there will be obstacles.

Anderson said he expects opposition to the project and possible legal challenges but said, "I don't think I'd be sitting here today if I didn't think we could continue on the path to building and executing on this project."

The TransMountain project expects to produce 15,000 construction jobs, and generate \$4.5 billion in tax revenue for the federal and provincial governments.
