Merritt Green Energy project stalls

After rumours of a sub-contractor's bankruptcy and the discovery that all the gas fittings will need replacing (extending construction by another year), the *Merritt Herald* has reported online that a press release from the public relations company representing Veolia North America and Fengate Capital Management Ltd. — the biomass plant owners — “stated that a dispute between Iberdrola Canada Energy Services Ltd. and a sub-contracted company has led to a work stoppage at both the Merritt, and Fort St. James sites.

“Work has recently slowed at both locations due to a stop-work order issued on Nov. 11 by FSE Energy, the sub-contractor responsible for the construction and installation of the boilers at each facility.

“The Partnership [Veolia and Fengate] understands that there may be legal action pending between the EPC contractor and other parties. We will not be commenting on litigation. The Partnership does expect that sub-contractors and workers will be treated fairly and paid for their work on the projects. We encourage all parties to resolve any contractual issues.”

Arts Council AGM report

There was unprecedented attendance at the NV Community Arts Council AGM last evening, so much so that the meeting had to be moved up to the dance studio. In the end, eight new members put forth their names for election to the board of directors in addition to the 6 incumbents, for a pool of 14 nominees vying for the 11 positions. This will be the first time in many years that a full complement of directors will sit on the board, although 4 of them are part-time residents.

And for the first time (maybe) ever for the Arts Council, voting was held with proxy votes as well as live votes in the room. Once the numbers were tallied, 5 new board members were elected: Herman Nel, Chelsea Werrun, Shannon Dunn, Tammy Steen, and Catherine Osborne. They will join incumbents Don McLeod, Chris Dooley, Bill Edmonds, Silvia Gillespie, Mil Juricic & Suzie Ireland.

Not everyone was happy with the outcome, perhaps the proxy voting was a surprise to some — certainly without it the numbers would have aligned quite differently. Several people in the group had hoped for a real shake-up in the Arts Council leadership, and there was wide-ranging sentiment as the meeting broke apart even before it could be ajourned.

But the volunteer talent that was present in the nominees! To be able to harness all that energy & experience! That would have been the real shake-up. There was community development, communications, and fundraising & grant-writing experience, and all with engaged art appreciation & a desire to help broaden the base of art groups that the Arts Council could nurture & support.

So hopefully those who had wished to get on the board and did not, will follow through with their enthusiasm for the work & the cultural expansion that their fresh energy could bring to the Arts Council. That would truly be a community arts council.


