TMX gets provincial approval

The BC govt approved the Kinder Morgan TransMountain pipeline expansion this week, after the company met the govt's 5 conditions. The project represents thousands of jobs, more than \$19 billion in potential economic impact and comes with a deal by Kinder Morgan to hire BC workers where possible.

K-M has said that the pipeline expansion — which will likely increase in cost from the projected \$6.8-billion — would need the approval of its board of directors in Houston, Texas. And it also said it is looking for a partner in the project.
