Come Read With Me introduces current fluency strategies to parents of grade one students to support their young readers as they move from learning to read — to reading to learn.

"Fiona Clare is one of the literacy experts who developed Come Read With Me in response to requests from parents who had heard of the great results from the One to One Reading Program, and wanted to learn the same techniques to use with their children at home. 


