Green Energy lien

Earlier this month, an industrial construction company in the Lower Mainland, TVE Industrial Services Ltd., filed a civil claim in BC Supreme Court, a builder's lien for nearly \$9.5 million for construction work on the biomass facility. It names the defendants as: FSE Energy, Iverdrola Energy Projects Canada Corp, Merritt Green Energy LP, Merritt Green Energy General Partner Ltd., Avanlee Farm Ltd., Best Coast Real Estate Inc., City of Merritt, Nicola Valley Rodeo Assoc., Nicola Valley Fair Assoc., Tolko Industries Ltd., Fort St. James Green Energy LP, & Fort St. James Green Energy GP Ltd.

This comes on the heels of the news of the bankruptcy of the boiler contractor also named in the lien; the closing of Tolko Merritt, its primary fuel supplier; and rumours of substandard gas fittings, and more recently, burst water lines.

Currently, the stop-work order issued in November remains in effect.

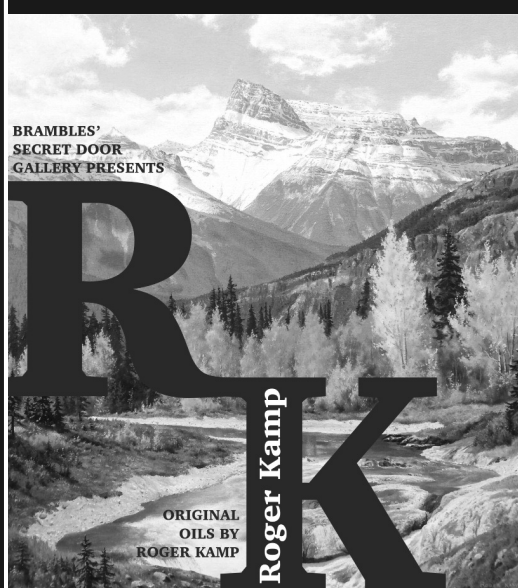
