Carfentanil confirmed

The deadly drug carfentanil is now confirmed to be present in Interior Health. This comes following a positive carfentanil drug test in the Kootenay region reported by Health Canada, and a positive carfentanil urine test in the Thompson Cariboo Shuswap region reported by LifeLabs. The drugs tested by Health Canada were illegal imitation oxycodone tablets with the markings CDN 80. The drug involved in the positive urine test is unknown.

"These recent findings confirm our suspicions and anecdotal reports that carfentanil is present in IH communities," said Dr. Trevor Corneil, Chief Medical Health Officer with Interior Health.

There is no reliable way for people to know with certainty if fentanyl, carfentanil or other potentially toxic components are in illegal drugs. Overdoses caused by carfentanil require larger quantities of naloxone and are more likely to be lethal. FMI interiorhealth.ca
