

Earth Hour report

BC Hydro reports that British Columbians saved 24 megawatt hours of electricity and reduced the provincial electricity load by 0.3% during Earth Hour, on Saturday night – the equivalent of turning off about 1.1 million LED lightbulbs. The Southern Interior consumed 7.9 megawatts (1.7%) less.

You can view your electricity use for Saturday evening by logging onto your online account, and comparing to the same time period the previous Sat., March 18.


