Fire prohibition in the Merritt Fire Zone

Effective at noon on May 19, the size of open fires will be restricted in the Kamloops Fire Centre (including the Merritt Fire Zone, all elevations) to help prevent human-caused wildfires and protect the public. Anyone conducting Cat. 2 or Cat. 3 open burns in these areas must extinguish those fires by noon on May 19. This prohibition will remain in effect until Oct. 15, or until further notice.

Prohibited activities include: burning more than 2 open fires of any size at the same time; stubble or grass fires of any size over any area; the use of fireworks or burning barrels of any size or description; the use of binary exploding targets.

This prohibition does not ban campfires smaller than a .5m high x .5m wide and does not apply to cooking stoves that use gas, propane or briquettes.

Anyone found in contravention of an open burning prohibition may be issued a ticket for \$1150 or, if convicted in court, may be fined up to \$100,000 and sentenced to 1 year in jail. If the contravention causes or contributes to a wildfire, the person may be subject to a penalty of up to \$10,000 and be ordered to pay all firefighting and associated costs.

Service BC offices are located in Kamloops, Merritt at 2194 Coutlee Ave., and Ashcroft. They will offer: DFA applications forms for homeowners, tenants, small businesses, farms and charitable organizations; copies of the DFA Guide; fax or e-mail completed applications to the Emergency Management Office in Victoria; access to the DFA Call Centre phone number 1.888.257.4777 and website.


