Vintage Car Club driving tour

The Vintage Car Club of Canada driving tour, consisting of more than 50 vintage vehicles and 122 participants, will overnight in Merritt on June 13th.

This tour starts in Abbotsford and goes to Prince George, following the same roads that were driven in the first tour 50 years ago in 1967.

The cars will arrive in Merritt around 4pm on Tuesday, June 13, and will meet at the Baillie House and the Grand Pub & Grill, where drivers will have dinner.

The public is welcome to view the cars at either location. Local residents are active with the organization, and the Governors of the 24 Chapters of the VCCC hold two General Meetings in Merritt each year at the Coldwater Hotel.

Nicola Valley mosquito control update

TNRD and its Mosquito Control contractor, Duka Environmental Services Ltd., have begun mosquito control efforts in both Electoral Areas M & N.

After initial larval surveys and habitat monitoring in mid-April, field personnel have been conducting regular surveillance and treatment of larval mosquito development sites. They have also met with private property owners, ranchers, First Nations, local facility managers and operators to confirm property access and review program procedures and operations.

And in response to unprecedented flooding, several aerial treatments have been strategically conducted in areas with active larval development sites, such as the Douglas Lake area, Quilchena, and in low-lying areas adjacent the Lower Nicola and Upper Nicola River areas. Ground-based and additional aerial applications will be completed where necessary and as required. Ongoing monitoring of river and lake level effects on larval mosquito development and distribution will continue throughout the season.

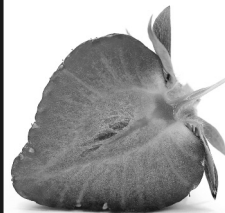
