Bass Coast: year 5

Bass Coast, the friendly festival, is back this weekend for its 5th year in Merritt — and they are in growth mode!

Tickets sold out in early spring, the full 4500 that organizers have capped the event at. And 1500 of those ticket holders have sprung for the extra charge for 'early entry' on Thursday at noon, extending the weekend for 1/3 of attendees. They've also expanded the first aid station, and harm reduction facilities. Garbage & recycling stations are everywhere, the site is completely glass-free, and water-drinking stations have been added to deal with the high temperatures. They've also added two licensed bars featuring cocktails and craft beers. As well, this year's is the largest artisan village yet, and organizers awarded 53 art grants for art installations.

Bass Coast has received a Creative BC grant which has helped them improve the stage environments and facilitate live stream broadcasts from the festival on their website: basscoast.ca

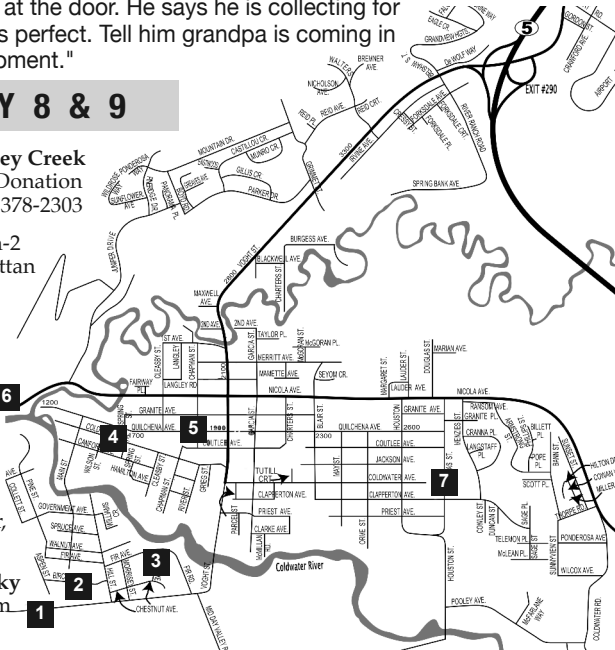

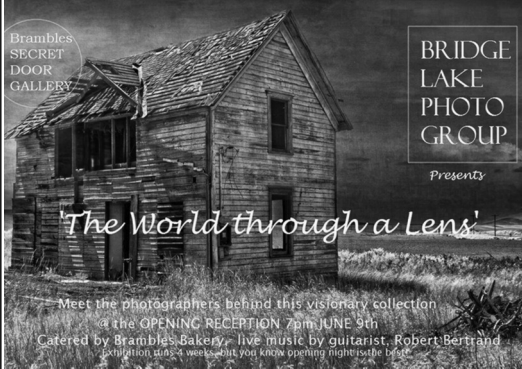
