

Provincial state of emergency

With the wildfire situation on Friday, the Province took the extraordinary measure of declaring a provincial state of emergency, which gives agencies such as Emergency Mgt BC, the Fire Commissioner, Ministry of Forests and the RCMP authority under the Emergency Program Act to take every action necessary to fight these wildfires and protect residents and

Campfires were banned in the whole southern half of the province on Friday.

In the Nicola Valley

Locally on Friday, Merritt Fire Rescue put out a fire around 11:30pm on Fox Farm Rd. They assume it was human caused.

Three small fires are listed on MoF's Wildfire website: Approx. 3.5km up Jack Swartz Rd on Saturday, a fire spread from a campfire. Area residents were quick to report it, and the Lower Nicola Fire Department and local forestry team made quick work of it, before it could get away.

Saturday, a fire on Comstock Rd, suspected to be person-caused, was put out while it was still only 0.6 ha in size. And a new fire was reported yesterday on Lundbom Hill: no word on progress there.

The fire danger rating for our area is forecast to remain at level 5, 'extreme'.

Thick smoke in the valley built up through the morning Saturday, obliterating the local hills, but cleared up late afternoon.

In the province Currently, there are 220 wildfires burning across the province, with only 129 larger than 0.1 hectare in size. Approx. 140 fires started on Friday and another 100 sparked on Saturday. There are 23,697 hectares on fire and authorities say that number is likely to grow. The fore-

warm clothes, blankets and pillows. cast for most parts of BC calls for dry conditions and hot temperatures for the next week and likely even longer. So the 'best-case scenario' for BC would be a provincewide rain event, but that is unlikely to happen.

Evacuations With this week's forecast, the number of evacuees province-wide — approx. 7000 — will most certainly grow before it shrinks. On Saturday, 31 people from an assisted living facility in the Ashcroft area were accommodated at The Florentine, and they were expecting more from 100 Mile House. Children attending Camp Tulahead on the road to Princeton were evacuated to the NV Evangelical Church this weekend. The camp will remain closed for the foreseeable future.

Fires of note in our area As of yesterday, the fire 10km north-east of Princeton was estimated to be 1500 hectares and classified as 'out of control'. 50 firefighters, 2 helicopters, heavy equipment and support personnel are on site.

The fire at the Ashcroft Reserve is now estimated to be 4400 hectares, with 80 firefighters, 7 helicopters, heavy equipment and support personnel on site. Due to poor visibility at the last update, officials said it was not possible to determine the number of structures that have been affected. The cause of the fire is unknown at this time, and they will conduct an investigation when it is safe to access the area.
