For a Good Time, Call Jackie Bass Coast Festival

If you didn't attend, but you're curious about this electronic music and art festival, listen up. It's a trip! With my press pass in hand, I attended Fri. afternoon & Sun. night, but Sunday night was by far the best — sun going down on a hot day, people flowing out of the river onto the dance floors, art installations & people lit up, literally & figuratively. The last night, main stage, kinda like Disneyland, where it just gets better after dark.

In the past, I've wandered around, but this time I planted myself in one spot to observe the goings on. Nothing like a notebook to draw attention, and it was splendid to have festers approach me to chat.

Q: Why do you return to BassCoast?

A: It's a culture and my community. I have been making the 9-hr drive from Vanderhoof for 4 years, meeting my friend from Nelson. The people here are closer to me than my family, and I see them only this one time in the year. This is where where we come to love & look after each other. A: It's my therapy for the year. I've been coming for 5 years and it's where I am able to detox from normal life. I can let my guard down, make my friend connections, get exercise, enjoy new social connections, share from a deep place, and practice openness and empathy in a safe space. It's a Bro-Fest. A: This is where I come to fill my cup for the rest of the year...with love.

Q: So, are drugs involved for you?

A: Yes, on Friday I did mushrooms, on Saturday, I did nitrous and E, today I'm saving my E for dancing later.

Q: So, won't you be burned out after all this is over? A: Yes, I may be low for a few days, but the glow from the whole experience lasts at least 3 months. (45-yr old engineer!)

Q: What is the best part of BassCoast? A: It's where I get to enjoy all of my favourite things: dancing, dressing up in costume, music, friends, people watching, and general debauchery. A: I have been attending raves since I was 18 & I'm now 41. I am a member of 3 rave groups that are here at BassCoast. A: I have come for 4 years, including when it was held in Squamish. It's smaller and more chill than Shambhala. We always camp next to The Bus Crew, 30-35 people who arrive in a big painted bus, and it's so fun to hang with everyone every year. A: Adding to my costumes each year. I have 3 tickle trunks full of fun clothes. A: It's kinda like Mardi Gras where people get to break out of the norm. It's where they encourage "only participants, no spectators".

Clearly, in a world starved for a sense of community, this is one place where they come to find theirs. I'm sure that if I'd needed to, I could've crash on a comfy couch, with my head on the heart stamped pillow, pull the sparkly blankie over me. Oh, what a feeling!

Merritt wilderness area closures

The City of Merritt has closed some areas to the public: the Tom Lacey Memorial Trail above the Bench, Windy Canyon & Norgaard's lookout. They are also urging residents use extreme caution while smoking in all areas of the city. Closures remain in effect until further notice.

The economic tolls of wildfires

The BC wildfires are starting to exact an economic toll, forcing companies in the forestry and mining sectors to scale back or suspend operations altogether. About 30-40 logging companies from Merritt, to Williams Lake have shut down harvesting operations.

In the Merritt Forest Dist. area, it has been left up to logging companies whether to continue working or not, with the understanding that if a fire starts due to their activities, they will be held responsible for all fire suppression costs. Any companies are working are generally hauling out the processed wood so that it doesn't become fuel for a fire. Meanwhile, no one knows when they'll be able to get back into the bush.

And to date, the BC govt has spent an estimated \$53.5 million on fighting the fires — and it's still early in the season!
