Headed for 'Drought Level 3'

Patrick Farmer, water stewardship specialist for the Min. Forests, Lands and Natural Resources Operations, requested of City Council a voluntary water use reduction of 30%.

He explained that the drought level for the Coldwater River at the beginning of this month was at level 2, but was expected to rise to level 3 within a few days.

With the past 2 months being extremely dry — 12% of normal precipitation — and record-setting temperatures, river water temperatures in the Nicola Valley are very high.

The Coldwater is expected to continue to drop, and officials fear similar or worse flow conditions than last year.

City Council agreed to further restrict sprinklering by eliminating Wednesdays & Thursdays from the watering schedule.

They will stop watering the cemetery and all parks, to contribute their part.

ATV ban on Crown land

As of last Friday, the operation of any off-road vehicle for recreational purposes on Crown land will be prohibited throughout the Cariboo, Kamloops and Southeast Fire Centres. And, all on-highway vehicles must remain on defined road surfaces.

But BC Wildfire Service compliance officers report that non-compliance was an issue over the long weekend, particularly in the Merritt Fire Zone. "It's a fairly new ban, so we are hoping the message gets across that it's not allowed right now," said BC Wildfire info officer Rachael Witt.

This prohibition does not apply to private lands or national parks. It also does not apply to emergency responders or to agriculture or commercial/industrial users who operate vehicles for farming, emergency response or business purposes.

August is traditionally the most active part of the wildfire season. Given the number of fires currently burning in the province, the elevated fire danger ratings and the extremely dry conditions, the BC Wildfire Service is strongly urging British Columbians and visitors to stay out of the backcountry in these regions.

The BC Wildfire Service continually monitors conditions and this prohibition may be expanded or rescinded as needed.

Anyone found in contravention of this prohibition may be issued a \$767 violation ticket. If the contravention causes or contributes to a wildfire, the person responsible may be ordered to pay all fire-fighting and associated costs.

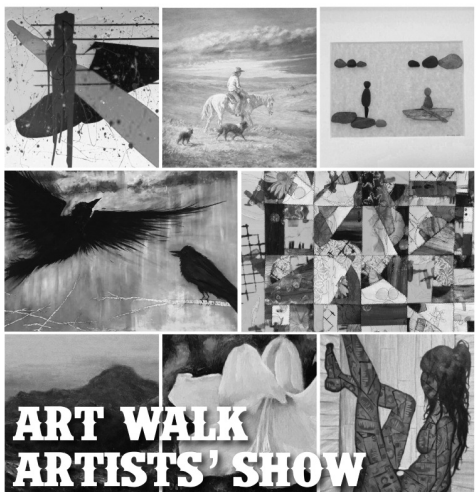

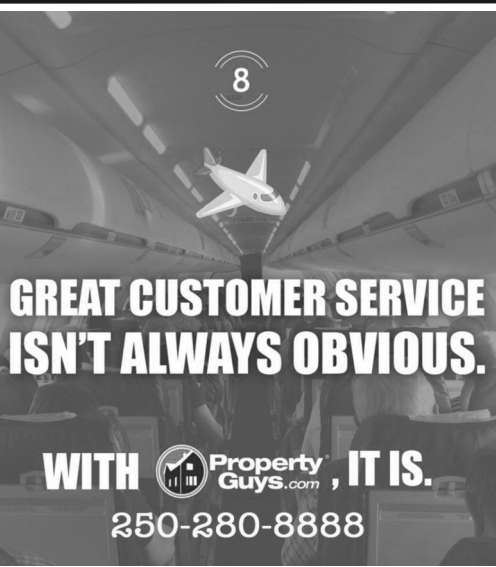


