Former Merritt Herald reporter publishes first political novel

Last month, Now Or Never Publishing released *Slouching Towards Innocence*, a debut novel by former *Merritt Herald* reporter — and former deputy minister and head of communications for the BC government — Ron Norman.

Ron worked at the *Herald* in 1981 before relocating to the Kootenays. In 2001, he and his family moved to Victoria where he worked for the provincial government. He was eventually appointed deputy minister and head of communications where he provided communications counsel to the premier, cabinet and deputy ministers, and led a staff of more than 200.

His novel is set in the quirky, combative, and darkly comic world of BC politics, where your friends can be more dangerous than your enemies. The story traces Malcolm Bidwell's rise as he becomes the "go-to guy" for every political mess that needs cleaning up.

And there are plenty of messes: from the cabinet minister caught in a vice sting on a trade mission to Washington, to the premier's deadly scuffle with a crowd that unexpectedly lands him in court and in a fight for his political life.

As Malcolm negotiates his way in what some call the world's second-oldest profession, he is forced to make difficult choices: between what's right and what's expedient, between his old friends and his new career, and between his girlfriend and a vivacious but cynical politico.

Ron will be in Kamloops on Saturday, November 11, at 1pm at the Chapters Indigo book store. Readers will be able to meet the author, ask questions, and have their books signed.

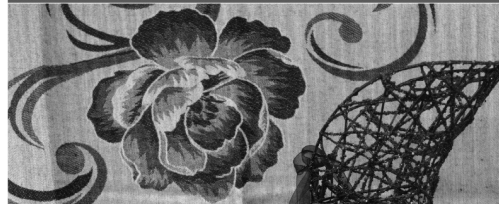
