

Kinder-Morgan pipeline flooded near Merritt

Dogwood BC's video, posted Saturday evening, had 37,000 views & over 1000 shares within 24 hours. It features Chief Lee Spahan pointing out a spot upstream of Coldwater where heavy rains & melting snow started washing out a section of the Kinder Morgan pipeline on Thursday, during that high water event.

Chief Spahan points out that at this time, there should be a foot-and-a-half of snow on the ground — but "it's (the weather) unpredictable", he says. He goes on to explain the Coldwater Band's history with the pipeline & its concerns for the future twinning project — vis-à-vis their aquifer and drinking water.
