It is with great sorrow that the family of Charlie Twan announces his passing on Wednesday, January 24, 2018 at the age of 95.

Charlie was a long time pioneer of the Nicola Valley, moving here from Williams Lake, BC. He was born at Fort Alexandria, BC on September 5, 1922 and married the love of his life, June Johnston on February 26, 1949. In 1957 he moved with June and their 4 young children to the Interior where he enjoyed many years of working as a ranch-hand and Cowboy, which was a profession he was passionate about, especially working with horses. The Quilchena Home Ranch was where Charlie and June raised their now 5 children, until he and June moved into Merritt in 1991, and later retired. Charlie also had a passion for doing leather-work and over the years he made several saddles, western belts and chaps for well-known rodeo cowboys, ranch-hands, as well as several family members. These are treasures that are still being used today.

Charlie is survived by his 5 children, Bev (Larry), Duane, Dayl, Shona and Colleen (Andrew), plus 9 grandchildren Larry-Dean, Lori-Anne, Jonathan, Jane, Stephen, Kelly, Carla, Wayne and Satara and 8 great-grandchildren (soon to be 9\*). With Satara, who was truly Poppa and Nanny's "little love", due to have her baby in the next couple weeks.

Sadly Charlie was predeceased by June on November 12, 2016 and his heart was broken. He grieved her greatly and was so lonely for her, his life was never the same over the past 14 months. But he is now with his true love and they are reunited again, together forever.

A "Celebration of Life" for Charlie will be announced at a later date, when the weather is nicer and it is safer for our family and friends to travel from afar.

**Update on IHA overdose alert**

In follow-up to the overdose alert issued late last week by Interior Health, a further update from the BC Coroners Service yesterday morning confirmed an additional 2 deaths in IH region that are also suspected drug overdoses.

This has increased the total number of suspected drug overdoses to 9 over a 5-day period (Tues, Jan. 23 - Sat, Jan. 27).

**TMX detailed route hearings, Seg. 5**

The National Energy Board announced last week that detailed route hearings for Segment 5 (Black Pines to Hope) of the Trans Mountain Expansion Project are expected to begin in late April or early May 2018, in Merritt and Kamloops.

The detailed route approval process will determine the exact placement of the new pipeline within the approved corridor.

Previously, the National Energy Board announced detailed route hearings for Segments 1, 2, 3 & 4 in BC and Alberta, as well as Segment 7 in Burnaby. Hearings for the remaining Segment 6 (Fraser Valley) will be announced at a later date.

Portions of the detailed route in Segment 5 that were not opposed by landowners or affected persons have already been approved. To date, nearly 56% of the entire detailed route has been approved by the NEB. Prior to beginning construction in these areas, the company must satisfy all applicable NEB pre-construction conditions.

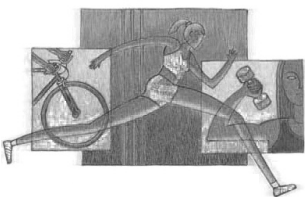
