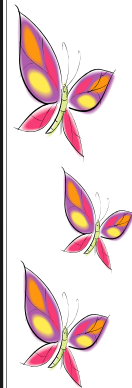

Merritt Secondary School youth you are that POT OF GOLD and I just want to say to you; I hear your voice, I value you, honour you and respect and accept you as you are! I love your idea of a "RAINBOW" crosswalk by your school, what a great message of inclusion, awareness and acceptance for all. At the same time teaching the true meaning of the colours of the LGBTQ rainbow (designed by Gilbert Baker in 1978) and what this means to LGBTQ youth. I hope I can look forward to seeing a large rainbow painted at the entrance to your school; since the crosswalk idea was not well received by Merritt City Council (shame on you!).

To Merritt City Council: To think that painting a "RAINBOW" crosswalk would set a precedent for other clubs to want to do so, is so far off the meaning of this rainbow painting, it is insulting. This is not about a group or a club painting on a crosswalk, this is about youth, humanity, kindness, love, caring, acceptance, safety and essentially BELONGING.

I invite you to read, "A Portrait of Canadian Youth" (Statistics Canada- released February 7, 2018); one section states; "About 4%-10% of Canadian youth consider themselves to be either homosexual or bisexual) and SOGI123 (SOGIeducation.org - the need to support marginalized LGBTQ youth in BC schools).

I also find it contradicting that a proposed "RAINBOW" message of inclusion may be considered starting something new -adorning side/crosswalks; as adorning sidewalks started with the city and the "WALK OF STARS" hand prints that are seen on many sidewalks around town. The city could at least give our youth permission to send a simple message of acceptance for the LGBTQ youth in our community.

So moving forward in a positive direction; SAY YES to the LGBTQ youth and all youth of MSS (today, tomorrow and forever) to paint a much needed "RAINBOW" crosswalk a beautiful visual message of inclusion, acceptance, peace and hope. This is the kind of Merritt I want to live in!
