Tick time again

Ticks are officially out in full force in the Nicola Valley!

Not all ticks carry the bacteria for Lyme Disease, and there is only a very small chance of ticks giving it to you. However, since it is such a serious disease, it is worth taking steps to avoid being bitten. There are other diseases passed on by ticks however they are rare in BC. Certain ticks may release a toxin that can cause temporary paralysis, so it's important to remove the whole tick as soon as possible.

Avoiding ticks: • Walk on cleared trails wherever possible. • Wear light colored clothing, tuck your shirt into your pants and tuck your pants into your boots or socks. • Put insect repellent containing DEET on all uncovered skin. Re-apply as frequently as directed on the containers. • Check clothing and scalp (covered or not) when leaving an area where ticks may live. • Regularly check household pets for ticks.

Tougher rules & fines to reduce wildfire risks

Effective immediately, the BC govt has increased some wildfire-related penalties up to \$100,000, to assist with fire prevention and discourage irresponsible off-road vehicle use.

All off-road vehicles are now required to have a spark arrestor installed when operating on Crown land. A spark arrestor is a small screen or other device that is installed in an exhaust system to stop sparks or other exhaust residue from exiting the tailpipe. Many new models of ORVs already have a spark arrestor. Owners of older models that do not have them will need to get them installed to be able to operate the ORV on Crown land.

A contravention could result in a violation ticket fine of \$460 or an administrative monetary penalty of up to \$10,000 if an ORV without a spark arrestor is operating at a time or place where there is a risk of a wildfire starting.

If a wildfire starts, the operator could receive a violation ticket fine of \$575, an administrative monetary penalty of up to \$10,000, or a court fine up to \$1,000,000 and/or up to three years in jail. The person responsible could also be ordered to pay all firefighting and associated costs.
