Weekend grass fire

Four BC Wildfire Service members assisted the Lower Nicola Indian Band Fire Department and Merritt Fire Rescue in fighting 2.5-hectare grassfire, burning near the intersection of Highway 97C and Highway 8 on Friday afternoon.

The fire mainly smouldered on the ground, and didn't threaten any buildings. "This is a good reminder that this is grass fire season in BC, the snow has melted in many areas and the grass still dead and dry and very combustible. We don't want people getting careless just because of the time of year," said BC Wildfire Service spokesperson Kevin Skrepnek.

Sharon McIvor, Dean of Academic Partnership & Development at Nicola Valley of Institute of Technology, was another one of the contributors to a book by *Whose Land is it Anyway? A Manual for Decolonization*, inspired by the late Arthur Manuel.

She said she also believes that education and the socialization of where First Nations people sit within the whole scheme of things, needs to be taken into consideration.

"This particular book is not really telling you what to do, it's here so people can read it and learn that there are a lot of things that they don't know about," she said.
