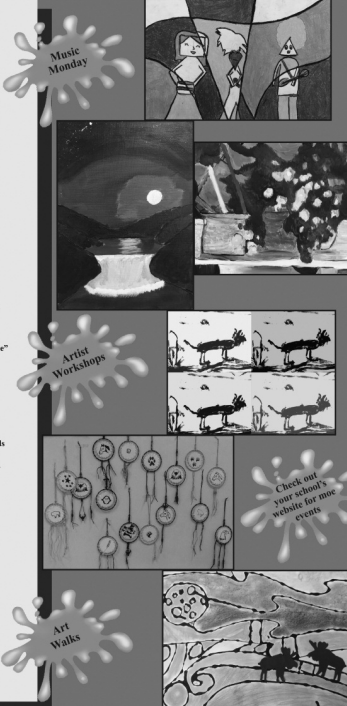

## Lt. Gov. Judy Guichon bids farewell

In a farewell ceremony at the Parliament Buildings Monday, Premier John Horgan thanked outgoing Lt. Gov. Judith Guichon for her service to the province.

She leaves behind a distinguished legacy: *Sing Me a Song* program, Lieutenant Governor's Awards for Excellence in British Columbia Wines, and she celebrated Canada 150 by visiting 150 schools throughout the province. Guichon served as lieutenant governor since Nov. 2, 2012.

As a lifelong rancher, Guichon was presented with a western saddle pad embroidered with the Lieutenant Governor's Crest and the Province's Coat of Arms. Premier Horgan also thanked Guichon's husband, Bruno Mailloux, and presented him with a Haida Dreamtime wool blanket, woven by artist James Hart.

The farewell included a 15-gun Vice-Regal Salute, and the Naden Band of the Royal Canadian Navy played the Vice-Regal Salute, in tribute to her service.

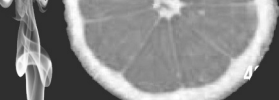

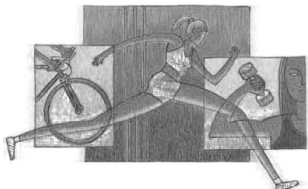
