## Local flooding

### Joeyaska IR#2 evacuation alert

The Lower Nicola Indian Band issued an Evacuation Alert Notice & Local State of Emergency on Friday, due to the potential of flooding by Godey Creek. Joeyaska Reserve residents were placed on Alert as a precaution, in effect for 7 days. The Band urged residents to prepare a bag containing necessary clothes and medicines to have at immediate hand should an evacuation order become necessary.

### Hamilton Creek IR#2 flooding

Meanwhile, the Upper Nicola Band declared local State of Emergency because of flooding at Hamilton Creek IR#2. Sandbagging has begun next to the Nicola River. An Emergency Operation Centre has been setup at the Band Office.

The City of Merritt has made available sand and bags for residents to use to protect their properties, in the Civic Centre parking lot.

## TNRD tips to prepare for flooding

As snowpacks melt and water levels rise, the TNRD is reminding residents to consider the following tips & info to stay safe:

- Residents can stay informed of streamflow advisories. Check with River Forecast Centre for updated info
- Never try to drive through floodwater. Water can be deeper than it appears, and levels can rise very quickly.
- If camping or walking, avoid small creeks & rivers as their channels tend to be narrow and can fill up quickly. Also, eroded banks result in unstable ground. Keep children and pets away from stream banks.
- Organize your emergency kit containing important documents, prescription medication, a flashlight and first aid kit. Emergency preparedness information can be found at [www.PreparedBC](http://www.PreparedBC)

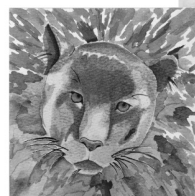

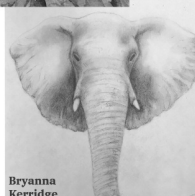
