Nicola flood update

The City would like to thank residents for reducing their water consumption over Sunday /Monday. At one point on the weekend, there was only a few feet of clearance in the waste water treatment system before they would have been looking at a sewage spill, but through the combined efforts of reduced use by the public and pumping efforts at the Waste Water Treatment Plant, levels are normalizing. Residents are still encouraged to conserve water where possible.

Voght St. will remain closed until flooding subsides & it can be declared structurally sound, where erosion has undermined the bank.

Tunkwa Lake fire

A wildfire flared up 5.5km from Logan Lake, on Tunkwa Lake Rd. on Tuesday afternoon, and grew to an estimated 150 hectares by evening. Ground crew members, 20 from Merritt & 20 from Kamloops, as well as air tankers were working on it.

Minute-to-minute flood info from the Merritt Grapevine

The *Merritt Grapevine* has come into its own recently, with the most up-to-date info regarding this year's flooding. Over the past 2 weeks, it has been the go-to site for the most current info about bridge closures, conditions of the alternate routes, and for those who need help to connect instantly with neighbours.

Erin Wiebe is one of the moderators of the Facebook group. She says she was living in Lower Nicola last year and realized how hard it was to get accurate info and let people know what help was needed. She wanted to facilitate a way for anyone who was affected by the floods and those who wanted to help to be able to connect with each other easily and quickly. She says: "There is so much stress and emotion involved in situations such as the recent flooding."

"What started as a simple post became something many people were relying on for information. I tried my best to keep up with all updates and actually had people on the front lines in Lower Nicola messaging me info as it became available so I could pass that along at the appropriate times.

In times of stress people need a reliable source of accurate info, not rumours and speculation. As there was too often not much info coming from official channels, I wanted there to be a way for info and eyewitness accounts to be easily accessible", she said.

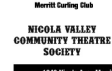

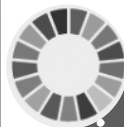
