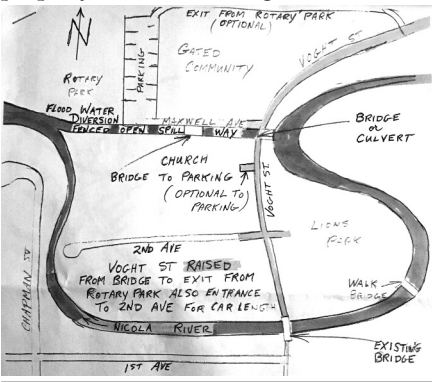
An idea that might help the flooding

It's an idea Don Schneider has been brooding on for several years, but after this spring he thinks the City should look at his idea for a diversion spill way. He thinks it could save lots of people lots of headaches, especially if the future looks anything like the last 2 years of flooding on the Nicola River.

Don thinks flooding could be minimized — especially for those on Second Ave. — if Voght St. was built up, raised level with the height of the bridge, and an open spill way was built to divert water from where the Nicola is closest to the street, along Maxwell, to where the river curves back into Rotary Park. That's phase 1.

Phase 2 would be some re-aligning of the river's course & dredging. Don says that the flood waters just can't flow fast enough through the meandering Nicola River. "I'm not suggesting a different course than where there's water right now," he said. He proposes some straightening behind the homes on Burgess & Charters, and through the golf course.

So Don has approached the mayor (again, he spoke to Neil after last year's flood & says he's more willing to look at the idea). And he's hoping there will be some discussion at tomorrow evening's property owners' meeting.

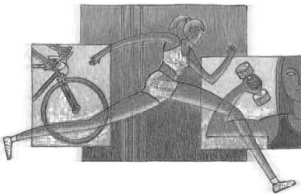
